2019-2020 Re-Enrollment and Tuition – Re-enrollment for next school year began January 11th via an email link, and our goal is to have 90% of our re-enrollment completed by February 17th, the end of Lutheran Schools Week.

Lutheran Elementary School Tuition Assistance (LESTA) and Pre-K Tuition Assistance – Thank you to those who have contributed to the LESTA and PRE-K Tuition Assistance funds. Applications for tuition assistance for the 2019-20 school year must be submitted by **February 18th, 2018**. Grants are awarded according to financial need. **Families must reapply each year.** The application for tuition assistance should be completed online through the TADS website (a link for TADS can be found on the school website www.stpmuskego.org).

Secondary Christian Education Tuition Assistance (SCETA) – Thank you to those who have contributed to the SCETA fund. St. Paul's members attending Wisconsin Lutheran High School or Luther Preparatory School for the 2019-20 school year are encouraged to apply for grants from this fund. Grants are awarded primarily according to financial need. Applications for SCETA fund grants are available in the school office. Application deadline is **March 15th, 2019. Families must reapply each year.**

Student Illness – Just a reminder, if a student becomes ill at school, the teacher or office will attempt to contact the parents first and if they cannot be reached, emergency contacts will be called. Parents or emergency contacts must come to the office to pick up the sick child. If your child has a fever or has vomited do not bring them to school until **24 hours** after symptoms are gone.

2018 Private School State Tax Credit - Parents with a child in a private school will be able to receive a tax deduction for private school tuition. Under the program, parents statewide will be able to deduct up to \$4,000 per student in grades K-8, and up to \$10,000 per high school student. To access your tax credit information, please follow these steps:

1. Log in to your TADS account
2. On the top bar click Billing
3. Click on the Household Paid Tuition Tax Report link. You will find it located below the big blue box.
4. Enter the tax year 2018

SCRIP Program – Your SCRIP purchases are paying off! Over \$4,000 was earned in SCRIP rebates this semester with 40 percent going towards St. Paul's Tuition Assistance Fund. The other 60 percent was distributed as tuition credit to families participating in the program. Letters were sent home today to families that participated in the SCRIP program and earned credit. Credits were issued in a lump sum, so if you are a SCRIP user on the monthly payment plan only January's invoice is affected – your remaining payments will be the same as usual.
