Live Generously Through Missions – Mission offerings are collected each time we have chapel. Our fourth quarter featured mission is to help support **Spread the Gospel in Ethiopia**. Every year the Wisco family pulls together to raise funds for a mission cause in an effort we call Our Hands for His Service (OHFHS). Driven primarily by a collaboration of student groups, OHFHS also invites our conference elementary schools to join the cause. This year, OHFHS hopes to raise \$30,000 for a ministry named [Taste of Ethiopia](#) whose mission is taken from James 1:27 that reads in part “. . . *look after orphans and widows.*” Our total offering so far this quarter is \$241.56.

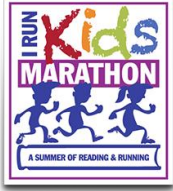
