School Happenings

Missions - Mission money is collected each Friday. Our fourth quarter featured mission is Wisconsin Lutheran High School Student Council's Our Hands for His Service mission project. The 2018 OHFHS project is "Let's H2G0 To Zambia. They are raising money to purchase a fleet of motorcycles for the traveling pastoral ministry in Zambia, Africa and to help provide running water to a local school near the Seminary we have there. Each quarter we will feature a different mission. So far, we have collected \$473.88 this quarter. The money donated throughout the year will be equally distributed to all four missions.

School Cleaning (K-8) –Time to sign up for school cleaning! We are making a change this year. We will be offering cleaning dates every Tuesday and Thursday from 6 to 9pm (except July 3rd). Credit for cleaning will be applied to next school year. New LES parents – are you wondering what this is? You paid a \$100 cleaning deposit (when you approved your TADS tuition agreement) registration. All parents cleaning will need to check in and check out with the cleaning supervisor and be available for the entire three hours to receive credit for their cleaning deposit. Immunizations – Two doses of the varicella (chicken pox) vaccine are required for students entering Kindergarten through grade 12. The Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) vaccine is required for grades 6-12. **All students entering Kindergarten or 6th grade next fall need to hand in an updated immunization form with these vaccines documented as complete by iFASST (information forms and school sign up time) on August 13, 2018.** Students in 5th grade will receive a letter next week along with an immunization form. Please contact your local Health Department or your child's primary care provider now to schedule an appointment to update your child's immunizations. Don't wait until the end of summer rush!

Lamers Bus form - ALL students who live in Muskego and would like to use the bus next year will need to fill out a new form. It needs to be filled out even if you used the bus this year. Bus forms are available in the office. Please fill this out and return before the end of the year. Thank you!
