

School Closing

By now many of you may have seen that Muskego-Norway Public Schools and many other surrounding districts have closed school thru March 27. Therefore, our Child Care Center, Pre-K, K-8, and Extended Care will also be closed during this time.

- By 3pm this Sunday, our teachers will communicate with you their "continuity of learning plans." Some teachers may communicate plans daily over email, and other teachers may lay out their plan for all five days. Thank you in advance for your support during this next week.
- Spring break will continue as planned from March 23 - 27, 2020. Teachers will not be providing alternative learning during this time.
- Information regarding when students will return to school will be provided as soon as practical but no later than March 27.
- This closure also includes facility use of our school and child care center for all co-curricular and non-school sponsored programs.

Finally, I include this statement from MNPS Superintendent, Dr. Kelly Thompson:

"This is a rapidly evolving situation, which we are consistently monitoring with guidance from the Waukesha County Health and Human Services Department and the CDC. We take the decision to close school facilities very seriously. We recognize the significant burden this places on our families, staff and community, but feel this is the right thing to do in response to an unprecedented health crisis. The welfare of our students, staff, families, and community remain our first and foremost concern."
